

Advice for going to A&E

- 1. Tell A &E staff that emergency hydrocortisone has already been administered.
- 2. Explain child has adrenal insufficiency.
- 3. Get the following measured:-
- 1) Urea and electrolytes.
- 2) Blood glucose concentration.
- Blood Pressure. 3)
- 4. Should any of these levels be abnormal admit for glucose, electrolyte and blood pressure monitoring.
- 5. Close monitoring for 6 hours.
- 6. Give double dose 4 hours after injection.
- 7. Recommend an extra dose at 4am which is double/triple the morning dose.
- 8. Continue regular monitoring of electrolytes and blood glucose until stable.
- 9. If on DDAVP your endocrine team must be contacted for further advice.

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
